**USACE Pass Drury and Little Dauphin Island Update:** The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) Mobile District has completed the National Environmental Protection Act (NEPA) analysis to repair the breach at Pass Drury. A contract will be awarded for construction in late June with construction anticipated to begin in Fall 2023. Construction is estimated to take approximately 60 days. The USACE, along with project partners, continue to evaluate the effectiveness of a permanent breach at Pass Drury as part of the restoration of Little Dauphin Island. Design of the permanent breach and restoration activities is scheduled to commence Summer 2023.

Give wildlife room, use a zoom. Getting a good look at Dauphin Island's beautiful wildlife is something we all like to do. But the safest way to get a close-up view of wildlife is through a telephoto lens, a spotting scope, or a pair of binoculars. For the safety of yourself and the animal, it's important to remain at least 50 yards away from wildlife. A good rule of "thumb" is to hold your arm straight and your thumb up when you see a wild animal in the distance. If you can't cover the animal in your line of sight with your thumb, then step back because you're too close!

Share the Beach We have 15 sea turtle nests on Dauphin Island as of June 22! We have had numerous crawls on all parts of the island, so it is very important to make sure our mamas have a perfect beach to come out of the Gulf and lay their eggs. Remove all beach gear every evening, fill in any holes in the sand, and either keep lights out at night, or use turtle friendly lighting. If you see a sea turtle (alive or dead), or what may look like turtle tracks, please report it to 866-SEA TURTLE.

Several species of area shorebirds have especially taken a liking to the freshly planted mounds as more than 800 nests were recently recorded by Audubon volunteers! The group solicited assistance from Alabama Power to build a number of "Chick Shelters" that were placed throughout the nesting areas and will afford baby birds protection from predators and searing heat. **Two New APPs Available** The town App is now available! Please download it for FREE to stay informed on events, meetings, updated emergency information and all things Dauphin Island! Mobile County now has a new mobile alert system as well! By texting MOBILEALERT to 226787 anyone can register to receive information, emergency alerts or other important messages.

Building Stronger & Smarter Regional and state officials joined the Insurance Institute for Business & Home Safety (IBHS) and the Alabama Department of Insurance (ADI) here on the island recently to recognize a significant milestone of 50,000 FORTIFIED designations nationwide! Based on decades of research by the IBHS, FORTIFIED is a voluntary beyond-code construction and re-roofing method that reduces storm damage by strengthening areas of homes typically vulnerable to high winds and heavy rain. A written statement from Governor livey stated in part, "With more than 80 percent of all FORTIFIED designations in Alabama, the state has become a leader in resilient construction and, increasingly, a model for the rest of the nation in creating a wide ranging solution to promote stronger, more resilient communities that can bounce back faster after a severe storm". Dauphin Island was also recognized for having more than 25% of all structures achieving FORTIFIED status! The group of some 50+ attendees toured the island to visit several homes and businesses that were constructed to meet these higher standards.
