The Town of Dauphin Island Town Council met in regular session at 3:00 pm on February 28, 2022 in the Council Chambers. In addition to the Town Council there were three (3) residents in attendance. NEW BUSINESS #9: 2022 CAR SHOW


A motion was made by Gene Fox to authorize Clinton Collier to move forward with the 2022 Car Show. Rich Colberg seconded and the motion passed.
