Both are invaluable to the sustainability of the island itself and to the birds and other wildlife who rely heavily upon these natural features. A list of beneficial shrubs is listed on the back. Large trees (Live Oaks (30" DBH), all other hardwoods (24" DBH), Pines (18" DBH), and Magnolias (12" DBH) or more and all Cedars are considered 'Heritage Trees' which are particularly important to our history, preservation and the ecology. These trees are only considered for removal or substantial trimming on a case-by-case basis by the Town of Dauphin Island Inspection Official or authorized designee.
