



Dumpster Policy

The Town of Dauphin Island is pleased to provide dumpsters for our community. This service is universally popular and we hope to be able to continue it, however in order to do so it is necessary that we observe the existing policy.

This service is provided free for the benefit of property owners on Dauphin Island (regardless of full or part time residence). We understand that some property owners may require hired help to handle their debris but as long as the property owner is present and can verify property ownership (Driver's license, utility bill, tax bill, or other documentation) this will also be no charge.

In addition, contractors are permitted to use the dumpsters for a fee and within certain limits. Local contractors (those with a Dauphin Island business address) may dump up to a quantity of 2 (two) cubic yards of debris for a fee of \$25 payable at the Town Hall. Contractors who do not have a Dauphin Island business address may dump up to a quantity of 2 (two) cubic yards of debris for a fee of \$50 payable at the Town Hall. **Note that the Town Hall is not open on the weekends or evenings - so plan accordingly.**

Items which may not be dumped are: Hazardous materials of any kind, automobile tires, batteries, household trash, paint, or oil.

Please be courteous to our dumpster attendant. They didn't make these rules, but it's their job to enforce them for the benefit of the entire community. All directions of the attendant must be followed, and their determination of eligibility as a property owner, as well as the quantity/volume or suitability of debris are final. We hope you will understand that this will allow our community to continue to enjoy this service as safely and efficiently as possible.
